Elementary: Going Out Permission Slip

What is a Going Out?

Going Out is not a "field trip" for the entire group; it is an activity organized by 2 or 3 students who would like to seek some additional information for a particular project or interest. This activity provides many organizational and practical life opportunities for the small group. The class has procedures for scheduling a going-out. Students must have reached a level of personal responsibility to be trusted to conduct themselves on such an adventure.

Reasons for Going Out can consist of:

- To gather more information about a research topic
- To get groceries for a cooking project
- To get consumables for the classroom or special projects
- To go to the public library

Specifics

- Groups will be limited to a reasonable number of children, and an adult will accompany the children at all times.
- All children will use a seat belt when traveling by car, and children will not sit in the front seat of a
 vehicle. Any child requiring a car seat/booster seat may bring their own or borrow one from the
 school. Children who are under eight or under eighty pounds will require a booster seat, whether
 they use one outside of school or not.
- Part of this work teaches children how to use a phone and send emails. There will be times that you get a phone call from the school or the MEMS Elementary phone. This number will appear as "Jeremy Grogan" from Austin, TX at (737) 615-2485. This call will be in regard to your child(ren) calling to ask about a Going Out.
- Going Out is a process that involves many important components. Your child's teacher will discuss this further at Parent Orientation.
- Chaperones are a necessary and much appreciated part of our Going Out program, where the focus is on helping to keep their assigned group of children safe and cared for.
- We have many families with younger siblings, and unfortunately, we can't accommodate siblings joining the trip.

Going Out Driver Volunteer Form (Elementary)

Our Going Out Program at Metro East Montessori School is made possible by parents volunteering to drive students to the Going Out location.

Montessori Elementary Going Out Chaperone (Driver) – Role Description A Montessori Going Out Chaperone (Driver) plays a vital role in supporting elementary students as they extend their learning beyond the classroom. In an authentic Montessori environment, Going Out experiences are student-initiated, small-group excursions designed to deepen their research, independence, and real-world application of knowledge.

The chaperone serves as a guide and facilitator, ensuring the safety and well-being of students while allowing them the freedom to take responsibility for their learning experience. This role requires a balance of supporting student autonomy while maintaining appropriate boundaries for safety and logistical coordination.

Key Responsibilities:

- <u>Safe Transportation</u> Drive a small group of students (typically 2-4) to and from their Going Out destination using a personal or school-approved vehicle.
- <u>Supervision with Independence</u> Observe students without directing their activities, allowing them to take ownership of their research and interactions.
- <u>Logistical Support</u> Ensure students follow their planned itinerary while adapting to any unforeseen changes.
- <u>Communication</u> Maintain open communication with the classroom guide, informing them of any issues or concerns.
- <u>Safety & Preparedness</u> Follow all school policies for student safety, including emergency procedures and responsible conduct during outings.

Qualifications & Expectations:

- Must be at least 21 years old with a valid driver's license and a clean driving record.
- Comfortable supervising elementary-aged children in public settings.
- Understands and respects the Montessori philosophy of independence and child-led learning.
- Patient, observant, and able to provide guidance without unnecessary intervention.
- Must complete the required background check and safety training as per school policies.
